## Lodging will be in the cabins at Camp Kiwanis.

Meals will be served in the Lodge at Camp Kiwanis. Three meals a day will be served starting with lunch on Saturday July 7<sup>th</sup>, and ending with breakfast on Wednesday, July 11<sup>th</sup>.

**The cost is \$195.00 per camper.** This includes lodging, meals, t-shirt, 20 hours of clinical instruction and 4 hours of live situations and live matches.

**Camp Philosophy:** New technique will be demonstrated, then drilled with opportunities for live situations. Without live situations real learning doesn't occur. This is the foundation of our instruction.
